
Sending Email-To-SMS using the Subject Line

Email to SMS is a simple way of sending text messages via the internet.

The Subject Line of the email can be used to insert the text message content. This may be required for existing systems or you may find this method easier than using the standard email body method.

If your email address is registered for sending messages through TNZ, you can simply:

1. Open your Email Client (e.g. Outlook)
2. "To" needs to contain the mobile number you are sending to (*mobnumber@sms.tnz.co.nz*)
3. Type the message you want to send to the mobile number into the Subject of the email.



Ensure you have formatted the "To" email address correctly.

Below is the default formatting of an email.

It must begin with '0' for national messages or '00' for international messages.

If you have requested special formatting of the "To" field, your options may be different.

To send a national SMS:

→ [Mobile Network][Mobile Number]@sms.tnz.co.nz

displayed as 0213334444@sms.tnz.co.nz

To send an international SMS:

→ [Country Code][Mobile Network][Mobile Number]@sms.tnz.co.nz

displayed as 006143334444@sms.tnz.co.nz
